



Massachusetts General Election and Amherst Town Council Election November 6, 2018

Voters will receive two ballots on November 6. The State ballot includes contests for federal, state-wide and regional offices as well as three state ballot questions and two non-binding district ballot questions. The Town ballots include candidates for District and At-large seats on the Amherst Town Council.

EARLY VOTING AND ABSENTEE VOTING

Voters registered in Amherst may vote before Election Day at any of the following times and locations:

- From October 22, 2018 to November 2, 2018, Monday-Friday, 8:00 am - 4:30 pm at the Amherst Town Hall.
- Saturday, October 27, 2018 from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm at the North Fire Station, 603 East Pleasant Street and at the Munson Memorial Library, 1046 South East Street.
- October 24, 25, and 26 from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm at the UMass Student Union Building, 41 Campus Center Way.

Voters may apply for absentee ballots at the Town Clerk's office until noon on November 5, 2018. For more information, call the Town Clerk's office at 259-3035.
